

Why use Flickr?

- it provides the ability to view camera settings for photos (EXIF data)
- members can discuss and comment on photos taken by other group members
- it provides the ability to run a slide show for our meetings
- it allows the members to add their own photos to the website gallery
- provides a way for local paper to view images
- each member gets 1TB of storage



You will be asked a lot of questions about how you want your account set.


These can be adjusted later.


Make sure that you protect your copyright!

- add your name in the corner of your photos
- do NOT allow 'Creative Commons'
- photo quality? Disappointing if you take it down too low for a decent view of your photo, also time consuming to adjust. Consider disabling downloads.
